Highlights of December City Council Meeting*

Sale of “Old Schoolhouse” The Invitation to Bid was approved with one addition to the wording. (Since that meeting, it has been determined that the posting of this notice will be delayed while further research is done regarding the condition of the building).
Gaming Permit Application Following discussion, the subject was tabled until the January meeting, as further information is needed.

FY05 Certified Financial Statement Tonya Vanderpool will be contracted to complete the state’s Certified Financial Statement forms. She recently completed the FY04 statement and the council is very pleased with her services.

Boat Launch Renovation grant The RFP for design and engineering will be posted for bids, with the construction dates of “between June 1 and November 1” to be specified in the scope of services approved by the council.

Committee Appointments A tentative number of appointments were made, pending further research in the McGrath Municipal Code. Confirming appointments will be on the January Agenda.

Community Profile Mapping Program A letter of interest from the City of McGrath will be written. This is in support of having TCC include McGrath in a grant that will provide this work to be completed.

Agreement to transfer VPSO vehicle to the City An agreement was signed by McGrath Native Village Council and the City of McGrath to transfer the vehicle to the city for use by the VPSO program. The vehicle was purchased for McGrath’s VPSO program through a “COPS” grant.



Vehicle Safety Inspections Drawing Winner

Parking on Chinana & Takotna Ave. prohibited

Please be aware that is prohibited to park vehicles in the following locations:

- in the opposite direction of authorized traffic movement,
- on the driveable surface of Chinana or Takotna avenues,
- in front of driveways or
- within fifteen feet of a fire hydrant.

In addition, if a vehicle (car, truck, snowmachine, 4-wheeler, etc.) is left unattended, standing, parked upon or within 10 feet of the traveled portion of a road in excess of 48 hours, it will be impounded.



Please “button up” for winter

If you plan to be out of town for a period of time during these cold winter days, please make sure to arrange for someone to watch your house while you are gone. The city staff is to be notified regarding who has a key to your house, in case emergency access is needed should there be a water leak, frozen water pipes, etc. As we all know, prevention is the best policy, as the aftermath of frozen water pipes is terrible to deal with and is a costly event, as well.
